 Lifesaving Award	<p>National girl award for assistance in saving an individuals life. Part of the Girl Scout program since the beginning of the movement in the United States, Lifesaving Awards are national awards given to a registered Girl Scout who has saved or attempted to save human life under circumstances that indicate heroism or risk of her own life. Local application that is sent to the national office for approval. The current president of GSUSA signs the certificate.</p>	Local Application sent into the national office for approval.
 Community Partner Certificate	<p>Honors individuals or organizations outside of Girl Scouting whose services performed greatly improved the operation and impact of a troop or troops (e.g. recruitment space, troop sponsorship, support for adult development, meeting space).</p>
