

Cookie Booth Etiquette

Since Cookie Booths provide an excellent opportunity to increase public awareness of the Girl Scout Organization, it is imperative that proper etiquette and behavior be displayed by everyone (girls and adults) at all cookie booths.

1. Always represent GSTOP with pride, following the Girl Scout Promise and Law.
2. Conflict should always be avoided at cookie booths. Remember the girls are watching and learning by everything that we as adults do. Troops that are involved in conflicts may be asked to leave the premises and may have future cookie booths revoked.
3. Adults should never leave girls alone and should always comply with the 2 adults and 2 to 4 girls at a booth location at one time. Questions refer to Volunteer Essentials chapters 4 and 5 at www.gs-top.org
4. Girls should be wearing their GS uniform at all times.
5. If your troop is scheduled for a booth, please get there 15 minutes before to set-up and take down your booth at the assigned time.
6. Take all your trash, including empty cookie cases and be sure to not leave anything behind.
7. Don't forget to bring all your booth decorations and sale materials.
8. Food and drinks should not be consumed during a booth sale nor should talking or texting on a cell phone.
9. Please and Thank you goes a long way even if they say no to purchasing cookies.

The person in charge should have your booth sale confirmation email with them.
